
ISBerne Online is a premium online school for middle and high school students.

We offer a High School Diploma with options to take Advanced Placement (AP) courses. ISBerne Online uses the Accel Management Platform (AMP) for Education.




BLENDED LEARNING

Our Middle and High School courses use the Accel Management Platform (AMP) for Education to deliver individualized learning for students globally.


Many students do not receive the individually focused and flexible learning they need in a traditional classroom setting.

POWERFUL APPROACH

- + NEASC accreditation standards are adhered to, with required attendance, standardized testing, and rigorous assessments.




FLEXIBLE

EXCEPTIONAL SUPPORT

- + Highly-qualified, certified teachers are trained to teach students enrolled in ISBerne Online. A team of subject-specific teachers are assigned to each student to conduct online lectures and discussions, hold office hours, give feedback and grade assignments.

ISBerne staff help coordinate any on-campus social activities at ISBerne physical school.





WHY STUDY ONLINE





Campus Residency Option

ISBerne Online students are welcome to enroll at the ISBerne Campus, subject to the admissions requirements and at the discretion of the ISBerne AG Campus Director, for a minimum of one semester and participate in a home stay experience.

- Students enroll in ISBerne Campus full-time and follow the relevant IB program
- Tuition follows the ISBerne fee structure. Please enquire for costs.
- No additional ISBerne Online tuition is paid during the Residency Option
- Please enquire for costs. Fees are paid to ISBerne campus, are in addition to the regular ISBerne Online tuition, and will be billed separately.
- Students who choose to do a residential or study abroad term may have additional fees for optional extra-curricular activities and testing. Those fees will be invoiced separately.

OPTIONAL FEES:

Graduation Ceremony

- Graduates of ISBerne Online program may participate in the ISBerne graduation ceremony in celebration held each June in Berne, Switzerland. The student must have completed the ISBerne Online program during the academic year.
- Cost is free for the graduate and CHF 50 per attending guest of the graduate (maximum 10 guests). Notification of intent to participate in graduation must be submitted by the graduate along with a reservation for the total number of guests by May 1.
- Travel and accommodation are not included and must be arranged privately.


Campus Integration Program
